Please note, students must have the following to participate:

Program Requirements:

- >> Be a graduating senior from a participating high school
- >> Be a Texas resident with residency in the following counties:
Dawson, Glasscock, Howard or Martin
- >> Students must pursue a certificate or associate degree, and enroll either full or part time:
 - >> *Full-time students must complete a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 17 credit hours per semester*
 - >> *Part-time students must complete a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 11 credit hours per semester.*
